

## 1.5 MILLION

Together, our **nine member food banks work with 2,700 agencies**, such as food pantries, homeless shelters and soup kitchens, to bring food to those in need. Collectively, our food banks and their member agencies **distribute more than 164 million pounds of food** to nearly **two million people each year.** 

Our food banks host more than 43,000 volunteers each year. Together, they donate about 423,000 hours to helping to eradicate hunger in Pennsylvania.

Feeding Pennsylvania provides a strong collective voice for hunger relief in Pennsylvania through a variety of channels, including programming and advocacy. Our statewide programs include Fill a Glass with Hope®, the first statewide charitable fresh milk distribution program in the United States, which brings nutritious milk to those in need. Whether it's an annual event such as Sack Hunger, a partnership with Pennsylvania's pork producers during Penn State football season, or an ongoing program like Military Share, which creates enhanced opportunities for veterans and those in the armed forces to get food, our goal is to ensure that no Pennsylvanian goes hungry.
